2. Use 1-inch margins
3. TITLE (CAPITALIZED)
4. Name of authors (underline and bold presenting author)  
Authors affiliations (name of institution, department, city and state)
5. Body of abstract (**no more than 300 words**) organize under the following specific subheadings:
